**Pre-entries close:** May 9 2025 (Postmark date) or when entries fill. Wait list will be kept. **Late Entries close:** If available, will be taken up to 20 minutes before the start of the trial

Entry Fees:

Pre-entry - \$15 per class (2nd Entry Same Dog Same Trial \* - \$9 per class)

Day of trial (if available) - \$20 per class (2nd Entry Same Dog Same Trial \* - \$12 per class)

\* Only if entering Open AND Utility in one Obedience trial with the same dog

Note: The AM trial and the PM trial are two separate trials

#### TRIAL SITE INFORMATION - The trial will be outdoor on sand/dirt.

Site available for setup from 3 pm - 6 pm on May 14, 2025 and open at 7 am trial days.

<u>AWARDS</u> – Flat ribbons offered for all class placements: 1st thru 4th place, Qualifying ribbons will be given for each qualifying score. New titles - Rosettes will be awarded for new titles. **High in Trial** – Rosettes will be awarded to the High In Trial, High In Trial Junior, High Combined (Open B and Utility), and High In Trial Aussie or Other Breed (whichever did not win High In Trial)

Special rosette for OTCH and UDX. If you may finish an OTCH or UDX during this trial, please inform the Trial Secretary before the trial.

#### ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

- Bitches in season are not allowed to compete.
- No entry shall be accepted from a dog or handler disqualified from the ASCA Obedience program; a dog or handler disqualified from all ASCA programs; or a person not in good standing with ASCA.
- Participation is a privilege afforded by the Host club and may be extended or withdrawn by the Host club's trial committee on suitable cause only. Refusal of such entries will be reported to ASCA.
- There will be no refunds in the event that a dog and or handler are dismissed from competition, regardless of the reason.
- A 100% refund will be given for any request received prior to the closing date. Requests for a refund of entry fees after the closing date, up to the day before the trial, will be honored less any expenses incurred by the Prescott Australian Shepherd Club, and will be issued for the following reasons: bitches in heat, dogs injured or ill (with verification from vet on request) or family emergency. Checks not honored by the bank do not constitute a valid entry fee. There will be a \$35.00 service charge for bank returned checks.
- These trials will be held under the current rules and regulations of ASCA.
- A copy of the current ASCA Obedience Rules and Regulations Rulebook may be downloaded free from the ASCA web site: www.asca.org.
- Exhibitors, through submission of entry, acknowledge that they are knowledgeable of ASCA rules and regulations. No entry shall be accepted which specifies any conditions as to its acceptance.
- When dog(s) are left unattended, they will be secured in a crate or x-pen. Owners/handlers whose dogs are tethered or improperly secured will not be allowed on the show grounds.
- Prescott ASC, their Boards of Directors, ASCA, its Board of Directors, and the property owners Todd & Sherry Butler assume NO RESPONSIBILITY for any loss, damage, or injury sustained by exhibitors, handlers, or to any of their dogs, personal property, and/or children.
